The Falls City Library & Arts Center has received three grants from the Nebraska Library Commission in 2020 totaling \$4,750 and an \$800 memorial donation.

2021 Youth Grants for Excellence received \$1,250 to purchase materials for new S.T.E.A.M. (science, technology, engineering, arts, math) activities. The family of Dixie Pethoud has contributed memorials to this project also. The goal of this venture is to introduce programs using science, technology, engineering art and math with technical materials and books so children are learning for our future world.

The 2020 CARES Act Grant award in the amount of \$2,500. The CARES Act purpose is to keep the library staff and the general population safe while library services are being provided during the pandemic with the use of infrared thermometers, face masks, hand sanitizers, gloves, disinfectant 99.99% effective against coronaviruses. This project is supported in part by the Library Services and Technology Act, administered by the federal Institute of Museum and Library Services and granted by the Nebraska Library Commission.

At the beginning of the year the library was awarded with a Nebraska Library Internship Grant for the amount of \$1,000. Our intern is Jocelyn O'Grady. This is currently on hold due to the pandemic.

We look forward to the time we can open our doors and resume programs.
